




Welcome to Suryagarh


We believe that we are not just a hotel but a representation of a unique way of life carefully preserving the traditions of our past yet framing them in a modern context.


High tea at the Central courtyard



Settlement of the Laudra Rajputs & Paliwal Brahmins:


Lodhruvapur was a glorious and prosperous city set up before the 8th century and you can still see the traces of the ruins of the city in the desert, but the one monument that is intact is the Jain temple of Parshvanatha. Rebuilt in the 17th century, its ornate torana archway is perhaps the finest example of its kind in Rajasthan. The city was ruled by the Rajputs of the Laudra clan along the banks of now extinct Kak river. The city stood on the ancient trade route of the Thar Desert and it is said that the river dried when the Bhatis shifted the capital to now Jaisalmer. The caravan continues along the dried Kak river bed and takes us to the settlements of the Paliwals. The Paliwals were people who moved from Pali and established settlements in and around Jaisalmer in the 12th century.




Dinner on the Dunes


Thar Dinner at Celebration Garden
